## Pre Nursing School

1. Research in your city what hospitals have a NICU and or nearest city with a NICU.

## Nursing School

1. Above #1.
2. Ask instructors if they know any NICU nurses that you can interview.
3. Attempt to either volunteer at that hospital with a NICU or possibly apply for a tech job at that hospital part time. (Nursing students usually get precedent in applications).

## Post Nursing School- Already RN

1. Get a job at the hospital that has a NICU and tell HR that your goal is to be a NICU RN once there is an opening. They may start you in PICU-Pediatric ICU.
2. Get your certifications if not done- BLS, PALS, ACLS.
3. Get NRP Certification.
